


<u>Vertus – 1èr Cru</u>

Mains Plots:

- Le Mont d'Epernay (Planted in 1963)
- Le Mont Souper (Planted in 2015)

80% Chardonnay
20% Pinot Noir
Brown soil on chalk, rendzine on chalk on the hilltops
Southern exposure for the Mont d'Epernay
East exposure for Mount Souper

Enters the "The Horizons" assembly.
Will only be dedicated to a future Rosé parcellaire called "les Monts de Vertus"






<u>Cuis – 1èr Cru</u>

Main plots:

- La Carrière
- Les Cuvelots
- Le Maizeret
- Vaubron

Young vines – 22 years on average 100% Chardonnay Main exposure North Cold soil – Late maturity Great acidity of future grapes

Etrechy – 1èr Cru

Main plots:

- Beau Regard (1964)
- Les Vignes (2002)

Rendzin on Chalk
Mainly old vines
South and South-West
exposure
Cold soil, cooled by the
winds – Very poor - Late
maturity
Leanness and great tension
of future wines

<u>Montigny – Vallée de la</u> <u>Marne</u>

Main Plot:

Les Grillons
50% Meunier (Planté en 1974)
50% Pinot Noir (Planté en 2009)

Sand on Marne, draining. Warm floor.
South West exposure.
Grapes with high phenolic maturity. Nice acidity. Very low yield.

Dedicated to the "Les Vignes de Montigny" cuvée and the "Les Grillons" plot.






The Domain André Robert: In the vineyard ...

Respect for Soils and Biodiversity

- Low intervention,
- Low amendment,
- Rational protection of the vines targeting the criteria of organic farming,
- Light plowing,
- Natural plant covers, and green manures sown
- Low yield.
- Certification: High Environmental Value









The Domain André Robert: Winemaking



Sharp artisanal winemaking ...

- Precise selection of the grapes entering the cellar
- Slow pressing, low sulphite, soft worked on the press exit
- Light and quick settling (Conservation of white lees)
- Very majority vinification on Barrels, Demi-Muids and Casks
- Aging 10 11 months with in without stirring
- Complement of blends on wines from perpetual reserves and wines of the year aged in stainless steel vats

.... Wine life for continuity!

Our work is artisanal. We interfere little with the path of the natural evolution of our wines. We follow them patiently so that they express their full potential, wines coming from life, from living soils for living wines.

Les Vignes de Montigny Harvest 2020

$\mathsf{T}_{\mathsf{erroir}}$

The cuvée "Les Vignes de Montigny" is crafted from two plots on the southern slopes of Montigny-sous-Châtillon, the Lieux-dits "Les Grillons" and "Les Vignes de la Haie Benoit." The exposure is full south on sands and marls, a mixture of clay and limestone. The plots consist of young Pinot Noir vines (15 years old) and old Meunier vines (50 years old).

Elaboration

Grape Varieties: 50% Meunier / 50% Pinot Noir

Base Wine: Harvest 2020 (100%) – Unclaimed Vintage

Vinification: 65% fermented in 228-liter barrels

Tank Vinification: 35% of the wine is fermented in tanks on fine lees

Bottling: July 2021 Dosage: 2.5g/L

The cuvée "Les Horizons" is predominantly crafted from our Grand Cru and Premier Cru terroirs of the Côte des Blancs. Each year, the blend is composed in proportions directly resulting from our tastings, our sensitivity, and the influences of the current year. The wine is primarily composed of the terroirs of Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Oger, Vertus, Cuis, and Etrechy, as well as Chardonnays from Vitryat. This cuvée is representative of the diversity of our terroirs, the profile of our soils, and subsoils (and thus of each of its horizons).

Elaboration

Grape Variety: 100% Chardonnay

Base Wine: Harvest 2019 (70%) - Reserve Wine from Cuis 2018 (30%)

Barrel Fermentation: 46% fermented in 228-liter oak barrels

Tank Fermentation: 54% of the wine is fermented in tanks on fine lees

Bottling: July 2020

Dosage: 3g/L (Liqueur specially prepared for the wine)

en Champagne) – Solera "Les Horizons" (40%) Barrel Vinification: 44% vinified in 228-liter barrels

Tank Vinification: 56% of the wine is vinified in tanks on fine lees

Bottling: July 2021 Dosage: 3g/L

Les Roses de Vignes

Harvest 2019

$\mathsf{T}_{\mathsf{erroir}}$

The cuvée "Les Roses de Vignes" is a rosé blend sourced from our parcels in Mesnil-sur-Oger, Montigny-sous-Châtillon, and Lisse en Champagne. The red wine is vinified from a selection of Meunier grapes harvested from our old vineyard in the Lieu-dit "Les Grillons" in Montigny-sous-Châtillon.

Elaboration

Grape Varieties: 50% Chardonnay – 25% Meunier – 25% Pinot Noir

Blend: Harvest 2019 (100%) - Unclaimed Vintage

10% - Red Coteaux Champenois from Meunier - Harvest 2015 from

Montigny-sous-Châtillon, aged for 36 months.

Barrel Fermentation: 100% fermented in 228-liter oak barrels.

Bottling: July 2020 Dosage: 2.5g/L





Terre du Mesnil

Vintage 2017

$\mathsf{T}_{\mathsf{erroir}}$

The cuvée "Terre du Mesnil" is crafted exclusively from Chardonnays from Mesnil-sur-Oger, mainly from the heart of the terroir. The selected plots vary depending on the tastings of the clear wines of the year. We often find the following named places: Les Vaucherots, Les Coullemets du Midi, Les Finciarts, Les Chétillons, which are parcels with very low yields, with a maximum of 5000 to 6000 kg/ha, producing grapes with significant total acidity and low pH, allowing us to harvest them very late and thus at full phenological maturity. These grapes enable us to produce wines of great depth, while preserving nobility and freshness.

Elaboration

Grape Variety: 100% Chardonnay Grand Cru – Mesnil-sur-Oger

Harvest 2017 (100%)

Barrel Fermentation: 100% fermented in 228-liter oak barrels.

Bottling: July 2018

Dosage: 2g/L





Collection d'Auteur – Le Mesnil sur Oger Vintage 2016

The Cuvée "Collection d'Auteur" is crafted exclusively from Chardonnays from Mesnil-sur-Oger, mainly from the heart of the terroir. The selected plots vary depending on the tastings of the clear wines of the year. We often find the following named places: Les Vaucherots, Les Coullemets du Midi, Les Finciarts, Les Chétillons, which are parcels with very low yields, with a maximum of 5000 to 6000 kg/ha, producing grapes with significant total acidity and low pH, allowing us to harvest them very late and thus at full phenological maturity. These grapes enable us to produce wines of great depth, while preserving nobility and freshness.
